


2015/2016 has been a tremendous year in the life cycle of Stepping Stones NI in the delivery and expansion of its services and social enterprises to support our mission...

In line with the organisational strategy and vision for 2015 - 2020 we expanded our services and social enterprises outside Lisburn to other geographical areas specifically Newtownards and Downpatrick.

On 1 April 2015 we opened our new social enterprise **The Garden Cafe** at the St Patricks Visitor Centre in Downpatrick. On 3rd November we also opened **The Gatelodge Cafe** in Newtownards and replicated our **Training + Employment Service** in this area.

During the year we also developed our own new **Youth Service** and expanded our **Training + Employment Service** in Lisburn. We were successful in our European Social Fund applications and are grateful to the funding support from the Department for the Economy, Lisburn and Castlereagh City Council and South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust who were instrumental to our growth.



We had many challenges in our new expansions and we are delighted to report that our new services have been a great success, and have opened up many new opportunities for people with learning disabilities across a greater geographical spread.
