Our team are experienced at supporting young people who have Autism, Asperger's, Dyslexia, learning difficulties and learning disabilities.

We understand that you may have complex needs or just require a little bit of help, and look forward to developing a personalised transitions plan suited to you. This will include:

- Sourced and supported work experience to help build your vocational skills
- Work placements in Stepping Stones NI social enterprises
- Short training courses to help prepare for the world of work
- Support in enrolling and applying for training, education or employment
- Taster Days for further education and training options
- Annual review attendance and support
